

MINUTES
FORT BEND COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 155

October 2, 2020

The Board of Directors (the "Board") of Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 155 (the "District") met in special session by teleconference, with access by telephone available to the public, pursuant to Texas Government Code Section 551.125 and Governor Abbott's emergency disaster declaration dated March 13, 2020, on the 2nd day of October, 2020, and the roll was called of the members of the Board:

Also attending the teleconference for all or part of the meeting were Constable Mike Beard and Chief Deputy Frank Cempa of the Fort Bend County Precinct 1 Constable's Office ("Precinct 1 Constable's Office"); Nellie Connally and Abby Derrickson of Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP ("ABHR").

Ms. Connally reviewed certain recommended protocols for conducting the District's meeting via teleconference. She announced that the meeting was being recorded and that consultant reports presented at the meeting were posted online and available to the public in the form of an "agenda packet" prior to the start of the meeting at <https://www.districtdirectory.org/agendapackets/fbcmud155>.

DISCUSS CONTRACTS FOR SECURITY PATROL AND TAKE ACTION, IF APPROPRIATE

Ms. Connally reminded the Board that the Fort Bend County Sheriff's Office contract is now on a month-to-month basis. The Board discussed scheduling options and preferences with Constable Beard of the Fort Bend County Constable's Office.

After review and discussion, Director Robach moved to (1) authorize termination of the security agreement with the Fort Bend County Sheriff's Office and notice of same; and (2) authorize the preparation of a security agreement with the Fort Bend County Constable's Office, as discussed. Director Telford seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

There being no further business to come before the Board, the Board concurred to adjourn the meeting.
