 - a. Lift Station No. 1 backup generator;
 - b. Benton Road Commercial Site;
 - c. Detention Pond Erosion project;
 - d. update on wastewater treatment plant improvements; and
 - e. deeds, easements, plants, and consent to encroachments.

8. Adopt Resolution Authorizing Application to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality for Use of Surplus Funds.
9. Update on detention/amenity lakes maintenance, including approve annual budget proposal.
10. Phase II Small MS4 General Permit.
11. Update on landscape maintenance and irrigation from GreenScape Associates, including:
 - a. District park and recreation improvements;
